URGENT NEEDS

- **Medical support**

Najdeh association: Madie 03 412 068

- Support for 7 families
- Need medications and drugs for nerves, dialysis, glands, asthma, epilepsy (Hemex 4000)

PRCS hospital: Doctor Abdul Aziz Al Bekai 03 359 987

Doctor Ahmad Khaled El Hajj 03 554 507

- 260 emergency cases have been treated since 4 days. Injuries especially from bullets and bombs.
- 12 cases for surgery have been treated
- 9 cases of bleeding
- Different cases of hypertension and nervous cases
- Diabetes
- Stomach cramps and dehydration due to the lack of water
- Hardest cases are referred to other hospitals especially Islamic Hospital, military hospital, al Reyrh hospital and governmental hospital.
- Need: 4 or 5 equipments to stabilize necks and backs

UNRWA clinic: Khaled Hammad 06 602 161 / 06 200 248

- Will provide us with a detailed needs assessment tomorrow
- By now: medicine for epilepsy, heart, milk for children, pampers, crutches, water mattresses, 4 hearing aids for children ages: 13, 15, 16, and 18 years old.

GUPW centre (near popular committee centre in Baddawi): Zainab 70 118 458

- 120 persons around 50 children – No injured persons there
- 1 totally paralyzed person (10 years old), 1 24 years girl with mental retardation, 1 8 years old girl with kidney problem
- Need: hygiene kits, pampers, hygienic towels, medicine for escars, Betadine
- Specific needs: one wheelchair, flet anima, diapers.

Gathering of persons in Abu Lfoz street

22 persons – 10 children

Nobody came to assess needs

No mattress – the hosting family provides them with food and water but no more

- Need: medicine for glands for an old women 60 years old

Gathering of persons in Abu Lfoz street

39 persons – 27 children

Nobody came to assess needs

No mattress – no food

- Need: calcium



Gathering of persons in the main street

One 60 years women staying in a cave. Diabetic

Did not come to the clinic

Need: insulin

- **Basic needs support**

GUPW centre (near popular committee centre in Baddawi): Zainab 70 118 458

120 persons around 50 children – No injured persons there

1 totally paralyzed person (10 years old), 1 24 years girl with mental retardation, 1 8 years old girl with kidney problem

- No food, no water

- Items already distributed by GUPW: 200 underwear for women, 100 for men and 360 for children / 204 small towels / 101 blouses / 150 women trousers / 198 veils/ 100 pajamas, 100 pajamas young girls.

- Need: slippers, mattresses, food and water

- **Psychosocial and psychological care**

- NG animation is closed but can provide a place for any activities (4 rooms).

- Animators from the centre do psychosocial activities (especially free drawing) for children in UNWA schools and support lonely children in PRCS hospital in Baddawi.
